Information

GES-2 House of Culture is an urban space that provides all the conditions for the development of the professional artistic community and contemporary culture. GES-2 brings together exhibition halls, a library, a cinema and concert hall, workshops, studios, and artist residencies, shops, a restaurant and cafes, a playground, and classrooms for public and educational events. The aim of the House of Culture is to introduce contemporary culture to a wider audience and encourage visitors to take an active part in its formation.

GES-2 is V—A—C Foundation's main venue. The Foundation works with Russian artists to expand the cultural space by organising exhibitions, publishing books, and holding educational events.

Description for social media mentions

GES-2 House of Culture is a public space in the centre of Moscow where a variety of artistic practices come together: from art exhibitions to clay modelling. We host workshops, lectures, film screenings, creative masterclasses, concerts, and performances. GES-2 aims to make contemporary culture accessible to all and to create the conditions for the development of the professional artistic community.

Mediation at GES-2 House of Culture

Mediation is a form of interaction between GES-2 House of Culture and its visitors. It seeks to foster respectful dialogue between all participants regardless of their experience, views, or age. GES-2 offers various mediation formats: from a conventional dialogue with visitors to vocal, body oriented, and game practices. Mediated tours are delivered in Russian and English, as well as in Russian Sign Language (upon prior request).

Information

V—A—C is a non-profit foundation set up by businessman Leonid Mikhelson in 2009. The Foundation works with Russian artists and fosters the development of contemporary culture through exhibitions and educational, publishing, and performative programmes. The Foundation's projects take place at GES-2 House of Culture, its venue in Moscow, as well as in partnership with various organisations around the world.

The Vaults

The Vaults Centre for Artistic Production comprises eight workshops fitted out with equipment for experimenting with wood, metal, plastic, ceramics, textile, and other materials. Created for individual artists and groups to work on their projects, the space is located in close proximity to GES-2 House of Culture. The Vaults is open to everyone, not just professionals: we regularly offer free mediated tours as well as workshops.

Begun in 2010, the V—A—C Press publishing programme represents one of V—A—C Foundation's longest–standing central activities. V—A—C Press publishes specialised literature on the history and theory of contemporary art, classical art history, post–humanist studies, contemporary philosophy, and art and exhibition projects. V—A—C Press also publishes children's books.
